My most recent publicly shared works, MUVA and Jenerasyon, focus on foundation and narrative building to address the barriers Black mothers face in achieving a thriving livelihood in the arts. These projects actively support and create opportunities by fostering a space where we share our stories, explore solutions through movement, are witnessed in the solitude of mothering, and heal together. With a strong educational background and extensive professional experience, I am but one in a small and mighty movement dedicated to honoring our narratives and to that end, advancing our careers as visionaries, worldbuilders and caregivers through my projects. My work fosters a sense of belonging as we echo our truths and validate our stories, essential in combating racism, ableism, and ageism, thereby creating inclusive spaces that value the existence of Black mothering artists.
